

NINE MEN'S MORRIS



Rules:


Stage 1 PLACEMENT: Take turns to place one of your 9 men (pieces) on any one of the 24 intersection points on the empty board. If you get 3 men in a line, remove one of your opponent's pieces from play.


Stage 2 MOVING: Take turns to move one of you men to an adjacent point. No jumps are allowed. If you get 3 in a line, remove an opponent's man.

Stage 3 FLYING: (optional) When you are left with only 3 men you can 'fly' to any vacant point.

How to win:

To win, a player reduces the opponent to 2 men or leaves them with no legal moves.
